RCIA Programme: The new programme will commence on Wednesday 5th October. The meetings will take place every Wednesday at 5:30 p.m. in the Library of Clergy House. Holy Mass will follow at 6:30 p.m. in the Cathedral. Please inform those who are interested. This programme is also open to anyone wanting to learn more about their faith.

FIRST COMMUNION PROGRAMME – Registration for First Holy Communion will be open until **30th September**. Please ensure you fill in the registration form at the back of the church and hand it, together with the Baptismal Certificate, into the office. Canon will contact you to arrange a meeting to discuss requirements and expectations before classes start. Maria Davies will contact parents to arrange a start date for classes. NB: I would remind you that children need to be in Year 2 or above to make their Holy Communion.

Requests for Baptismal Certificates must be submitted in **writing** by letter or email (parish email address above). Please provide as much information as possible. **No personal callers please.** We aim to process your request a.s.a.p. We will contact you when the document is ready to be collected. N.B.: For security purposes, you will need to provide evidence of your relationship to the child when you collect.
