October Devotions: Throughout the month of October, there will be Rosary and Adoration after all the weekday Masses.

The Solemnity of All Saints (1st November) is a **Holy Day of Obligation**. Vigil Mass on Thursday 31st November at 6:30pm.; Friday 1st November: Masses are at 9:15am and 6:30pm.

All Souls Day: The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed. Praying for deceased relatives and friends.

Masses is at 9:30 a.m. For those who requested for votive candles for deceased relatives and friends, please come before 9:30 a.m. to light your votive candle. If you are unable to light your candle, it will be lit on your behalf. The Cathedral will be open all day. You can come in at any time of the day to pray.

Votive Candles For All Souls Day: If you wish to light a candle for deceased relatives/friends on 'Holy Souls' Day on November 2nd, please write the name/s of your deceased relatives & friends on the list in the porch. Candles are £1 for each name. The name will be printed on the candle.

November Dead List: Please take an **envelope** and one of the **Dead List Forms**. Take time to remember all of the dead you wish to include on the list. Put the completed form and your offering in the Dead List envelope. Masses will be offered throughout the month for those whose names are on the Parish Dead List.

First Communion: Thank you to all who attended the parents' communion meeting last week. Classes have now commenced. Classes take place in the Parish Hall every Tuesday at 6 p.m. PLEASE NOTE: your child will need to be Year 2 or above to receive the sacrament of Holy Communion. If you know of any children who might be interested attending classes, please speak to Canon Benedict.

RCIA Programme – the new program is about to commence. Please inform those who may be interested. This programme is also open to anyone wanting to learn more about their faith.

Baptism Programme for parents: The Baptism Programme runs three times each year: September-October, January-February, and May-June, actual dates to be set near the time.
