RESUMPTION OF MASS SCHEDULE: Welcome back! Now that the "Firebreak" is over, from Monday, 9th of November we are reverting to as near normal service as possible, given the ongoing constraints.

SATURDAY EVENING VIGIL MASS: From next weekend, 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, we will be reinstating the Saturday evening Vigil Mass, scheduled to start at the later time of 6:00 p.m. Please note that, initially, we will trial this Mass for two weeks only, in order to see how practicable it is. The deciding factor will be the availability of volunteer Stewards & Cleaners to sanitise the church after Mass so that the church is ready for the 08:00 a.m. Sunday Mass. Volunteer Stewards will need to arrive at least 30 minutes before the start of Mass.

HOLY COMMUNION - IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO AVOID ACCIDENTS - Please either unloop your face covering or lower it before you step forward to receive Holy Communion. Extend your arms/hands fully and consume immediately. Then replace your face covering.
