CHRISTMAS SCHEDULE: This weekend is your final opportunity to sign up for the Mass you wish to attend. The 6 p.m. Christmas Vigil Mass is fully booked-up so the list is now closed. There are still some places at the Midnight and Christmas Day Masses but you need to sign up quickly if you want to secure your place. I will confirm the Mass schedule on Monday, based on demand and will publish this on our webpage. Please keep checking online for the update. I will also pin the Mass Schedule on the main door of the cathedral for anyone who does not have online access.

Indications so far, suggest Mass times are likely to be:

Christmas Eve Vigil Mass: 6:00 p.m.

Midnight Mass:

Christmas Morning: 8:00 am and 10:00 am

NB: Due to ongoing COVID restrictions, and to maintain social distances, we have to limit attendance at these Masses. Only parishioners who have registered by 16th December, therefore, will be allowed to attend. Anyone who turns up without having pre-registered will be refused entry.

Please also note that in order to comply with government regulations we need to have a sufficient number of Stewards in attendance.
