ERRATUM - DONATIONS FOR MAY

Apologies, there was an error in last week's published figure for May receipts. The correct totals for the whole month of May should have read as follows:

Loose Plate: Combined total of Standing Orders £2,777.21

and Electronic Plate donations:

£1,740.85

For budgeting purposes, we use the amount of donations by Standing Order and Electronic Plate to help us plan our future spending. The loose plate collection, on the other hand, is variable and liable to change from week to week according to people's circumstances so we are unable to commititin advance.

Correction to the May figure:

If you take the figures for the month of May, the total sum of Electronic Donations plus Direct Debits/Standing Orders is £1,740.85 - working out at an average of £390.84 per week. As you might appreciate, this is a great deal less than our weekly outgoings.
