SECOND COLLECTION - ENERGY ACCOUNT

You will recall that the second collection was introduced very reluctantly and out of necessity, in response to rising energy costs. Our financial situation called for desperate measures in order to pay the heavy winter energy bill. Thank you, most sincerely to all who responded, generously as always, by stretching their finances to help out. It has not gone unnoticed, however, that others are dividing their ‘weekly’ donation into two, thus halving the amount they donate at the first collection in order to give to the second collection. As a result, we now have a shortfall in the ‘general’ account i.e. the account that funds the day to day running of the parish.

Whilst I do understand and totally appreciate that many of you are managing on fixed incomes, leaving little, if any, surplus at the end of the week or month, I am nevertheless appealing to you once again to please, please stretch your budget as far as possible to enable us to meet this next electricity bill. Parents of young children . . .

Following on from my request of last weekend, I would, once again, respectfully remind parents that noisy children disrupt Mass and make it difficult for others to focus. Please parents, you are responsible for your children’s behaviour in Mass. It is your place to encourage them and teach them appropriate behaviour in church. Whilst we are actively looking at ways to re-introduce Children’s Liturgy, please kindly . . .

- Once your child shows signs of becoming noisy/disruptive, please take them outside into the porch briefly;
- Bring some quiet activities for children to do during Mass eg. colouring books, small (quiet!) toys etc.; and
- Keep your children sitting close to you, and in an area where they can be more easily managed e.g. near the exit.
